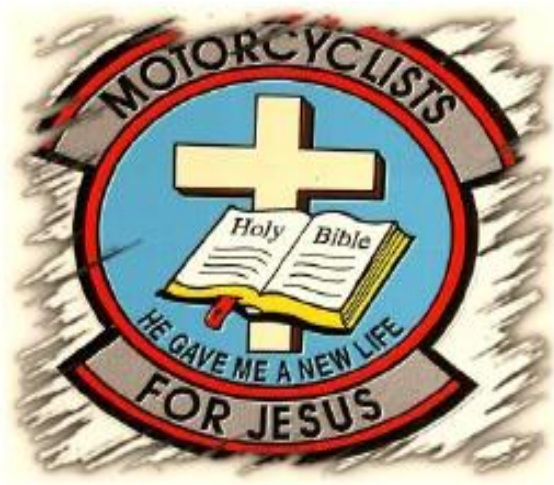

AWAKE & ALERT

Revelation 16:15 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition “Behold, I am going to come like a thief! Blessed (happy, to be envied) is he who stays awake (alert) and who guards his clothes, so that he may not be naked and [have the shame of being] seen exposed!”

The Romans in that time had a punishment for falling asleep on watch. They stripped off all your clothes and sent you home naked and in disgrace. Over 50 times we are told to be ready for his return.

(Mark Hitchcock in The Prophecy Collection)

Matthew 24:42-44 Amplified Bible, Classic Edition “Watch therefore [give strict attention, be cautious and active], for you do not know in what kind of a day [whether a near or remote one] your Lord is coming.”

43 But understand this: had the householder known in what watch the thief was coming, he would have watched and would not have allowed his house to be undermined and broken into. 44 You also must be ready therefore, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour when you do not expect Him.

There is a story of the college professor who would walk into the lecture hall each morning and place a tennis ball on the corner of his podium. The tennis ball didn't seem to have any purpose and at the end of the lecture the professor would put it back in his pocket and leave.

The students wondered why he did this but were never quite sure until a student fell asleep in class. The professor walked over to the podium and without any change in his voice picked up the tennis ball and fired it at the sleeping student, scoring a direct hit on his head.

At class the following day the professor placed a baseball on the podium. The entire class was wide awake from then on. The words of Jesus should serve as a tennis ball to the head for those of us who are drowsy and dozing in these ‘last days’ with all that's going on in our world today we have every reason to be awake and alert. In these last days Jesus should have our rapt attention.

I hope we get the point. The rapture is possible any day, impossible no day.

Mark 13:30-33 Complete Jewish Bible Yes! I tell you that this people will certainly not pass away before all these things happen. 31 Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will certainly not pass away. 32 However, when that day and hour will come, no one knows — not the angels in heaven, not the Son, just the Father. 33 Stay alert! Be on your guard! For you do not know when the time will come.

Mark 13:34-37 Complete Jewish Bible “It’s like a man who travels away from home, puts his servants in charge, each with his own task, and tells the doorkeeper to stay alert. 35 So stay alert! for you don’t know when the owner of the house will come, 36 whether it will be evening, midnight, cockcrow or morning — you don’t want him to come suddenly and find you sleeping! 37 And what I say to you, I say to everyone: stay alert!”

Waiting and watching for Jesus is active, it is not like waiting at a bus stop for the bus to show up. In the parable before of the man leaving the servants in charge ‘each with their own task’. Which means to keep the house ready for his arrival. Beds made, floors swept, garden tended; watching is more than just passively waiting.

Suppose you were a sailor coming home from a long voyage. The dock is filled with wives and sweethearts waiting for their men. As everyone else was meeting and embracing you see your wife is not there. Worried you rush home to find your wife inside the house. She says “honey, I’m so glad to see you. I’ve been waiting for you”. Would you tell her what you felt, “Sweetie, the other men’s wives and girlfriends were watching for them!” Likewise Jesus doesn’t call us to be passive waiters but to be active engaged watchers.

Jesus emphasizes at least three main actions that fill in for us what it looks like to be alert and awake in the last days. The 1st is protection. We must stand strong in the truth and guard our lives from spiritual deception. The sermon in mark 13 begins with these words from Jesus, “see to it that no one misleads you”. He later adds the warnings ‘be on your guard’ and ‘take heed’ the repeated warnings are clear that we must be on guard against false teaching that will proliferate as Christ’s coming draws near.

Mark 13:5-6 Complete Jewish Bible Yeshua began speaking to them: “Watch out! Don’t let anyone fool you! 6 Many will come in my name, saying, ‘I am he!’ and they will fool many

Concerning our motto, “In God We Trust;

Matthew Herman Rothert Sr. was responsible for having “In God We Trust” placed on U.S. paper Currency. He was a furniture manufacturer and president of the American Numismatic Association (ANA) from 1965 to 1967.

Matt Rothert was born on March 17, 1904 in Huntingburg, Indiana. Rothert received a BS from Notre Dame University in 1924, moved to Camden (Quachita County), and founded the Camden Furniture Company, serving as its president until he retired in 1975.

At church one Sunday in 1953, looking at the collection plate, Rothert realized only coins bore the motto “In God We Trust.” Coins had the motto on them since the Civil War. He believed that a message about God on U.S paper currency would reach more people because of its wider circulation. At that time was the Cold War and countries such as the Soviet Union, North Korea, and China were wiping out every trace of God they could. Rothert wrote letters and gave speeches promoting his idea. As a result, Senator J. William Fulbright of Arkansas, along with several other senators and representatives from around the country, proposed the bill to Congress. President Dwight Eisenhower signed the proposal into law on July 11, 1955.

In 2003 we had 540 billion dollars in U.S. currency of which 360 billion were overseas, each bill saying “In God We Trust”; what an evangelistic outreach.
