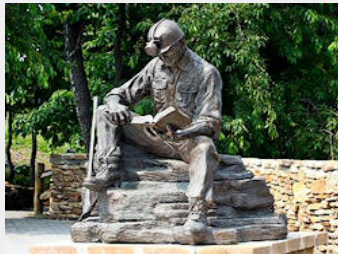

**Flight 93**

On Tuesday morning, September 11, 2001, the U.S. came under attack when four commercial airliners were hijacked and used to strike targets on the ground. Nearly 3,000 people tragically lost their lives. Because of the actions of the 40 passengers and crew aboard one of the planes, Flight 93, the attack on the U.S. Capitol was thwarted. With the new visitors center this is an emotional experience. This is all free to the public.

**Quecreek Mine**



We invite you to come visit the rescue site where you can walk right up to the rescue shaft where the miners emerged from the dark, cold mine 240 feet below after 77 hours of frigid darkness. You will be greeted by the 7 foot tall bronze statue of a coal miner at the top of the walkway into the rescue site. Hear the story of the miracle from people personally involved in the rescue. Touch the rescue capsule and try to imagine how it would feel to squeeze into it with your strength nearly gone. This has a \$7.00 fee to enter the visitors center all money is used to expand the center. The Visitors center has a film of the farmer describing the day's events from the first person that was doing surveying on his property to locate the shaft till the end when all 9 were rescued. There are also recorded voices of the miners when they hit water.

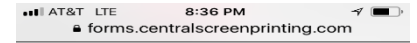

## TODAY'S CREATION MOMENT WATER INTO WINE

### **John 2:11**

“This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.”

John records in his Gospel that the first miracle of Jesus was performed at the wedding at Cana in Galilee. During the course of the celebrations, they were found to have run out of wine. Jesus instructed the servants to fill six 20-gallon stone jars with water, and He turned this 120 gallons of water into wine.

I have watched people carry out conjuring tricks, where a glass of water is stirred with a wand, on which has been glued a crystal of potassium permanganate, which colors the water a deep red. Jesus did not do anything like this, because the wine was tasted, and found to be just that – wine.

Today's wines might be just over 10% ethanol. Even if we allow that wines in biblical times were weaker, we can still assume that more than 5% of the water was turned into ethanol. That would be 6 gallons of ethanol.

Molecules of water are very different from molecules of the alcohol ethanol. Jesus had turned  $H_2O$  into  $C_2H_5OH$ . This shows Jesus' creative power. He must have made the carbon atoms in the wine from nothing. But then, He did create the whole universe at the beginning!

But there is more. The master of the feast declared that this was good wine. Good wine is that which has aged. The aging process involves some ethanol reacting with organic acids from the fruit to form delicately flavored and fragrant compounds called esters. But this process of esterification takes time; often several years. So Jesus was also showing that He is in control of the timing of things as well as their actual creation.

## The Time Between the Bookends

You saw me before I was born. Every day of my life was recorded in your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed. —Psalm 139:16

Have you ever thought about all the ways there are to measure time? We have calendars. We have clocks. We have watches. We have atomic clocks. We have molecular clocks. We have biological clocks. We have clocks in our cars, in our computers, and on our cell phones. Even the speedometer on my bike has a clock so that I don't forget what time it is.

When I was in elementary school, time seemed to take forever. It seemed like summer lasted forever. It went on and on. Then the school year seemed to go on forever. I still remember my grandmother saying, "If you think time is moving now, just you wait until you're my age. It whips by so fast."

As we get older, the years start going faster and faster. But as the psalmist David wrote, "Every day of my life was recorded in your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed" (Psalm 139:16 NLT). Isn't that amazing? God knows all the days of our lives. He has written them in His book.

A few years ago, I came across an interesting ad for a personal life clock. Its digital numbers flashed the remaining hours, minutes, and seconds in a person's statistical lifetime. How's that for depressing? Who would want to wake up every morning and see those numbers going down?

What time is it in your life? Ecclesiastes tells us, "For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven. A time to be born and a time to die" (Ecclesiastes 3:1-2 NLT). We have a beginning and an end. Birth and death are the fixed bookends of our lives.

Then there is the time in between. And when we stand before God someday, we will give an account for it.
