but rather rejoicing with us. Let the floods express their joy”.

God’s will is for all to be sensitive to the living Word that enables us to separate “the need to blame” ... as if we are just blowing in the wind to a life in the Kingdom of God. It is not a physical push but a spiritual reassurance that comes from the knowledge of his Word. It allows a free spirit that wants to follow the Holy Spirit.
