Kathy Dillon from the New Life Riders sent me the recipe for Chocolate Zucchini Cake. It's a good time to try it. Some of you may be growing zucchinis in your gardens.

CHOCOLATE ZUCCHINI CAKE

3 eggs	1 cup oil
1 tbsp. vanilla	2 cups shredded zucchini
2 cups sugar	2 cups flour
1 tbsp. cinnamon	2 tsp. baking soda
¼ tsp, baking powder	1 tsp. salt
4 tbsp. cocoa	¼ cup chopped walnuts

Beat eggs. Add sugar, oil and vanilla. Mix well. Grate zucchini, squeeze out moisture, then add to the egg mixture. Add flour, cinnamon, baking soda, baking powder and salt. Beat well. Add cocoa and walnuts. Bake in a greased 9x13 pan at 350 degrees for 45-50 minutes.

Enough about recipes ladies, have you read the July issue of the American Motorcyclist? Maggie McNally, the new Chair of the Board at the AMA, is on the cover. She was elected as Chair in February. 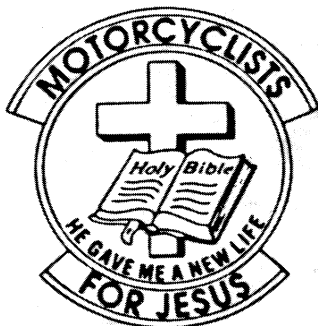
