America's commitment to the Bible was unwavering and was demonstrated in many ways, one of which was evident at the conclusion of the American Revolution. With the victory at the battle of Yorktown, America was finally free from British policies, including the long standing one against printing the Bible in English in America. Consequently in 1781 the plan was advanced in congress

to print America's first English language Bible. On September 12, 1782 the full Congress approved that Bible and it soon began rolling off the presses. Printed in the front of the Bible is a congressional endorsement declaring in part, 'resolved that the United States in Congress assembled recommend this addition of the Bible to the inhabitants of the United States'.

One early historian observed; Who will call into question the assertion that this is a Bible nation? Who will charge the government with indifference to religion when the first Congress of the States assumed all the rights and performed all the duties of a Bible society long before such an institution had an existence in the world. Noah Webster, the "schoolmaster of the republic," said that "education is useless without the Bible. The Bible was America's basic textbook in all fields." One could only hope and pray that our legislators today and in the future would be guided by adherence to biblical principles.

The Benefits of Using a QR Code

Have you ever wondered how your MJM TEAM might benefit from using QR Codes? Do you even know what a QR code is? The term “QR Code” is short for Quick Response Code. A quick response code is basically a square barcode that can be linked to a website or other source of information. You’ve probably seen QR codes in restaurants, offices, and stores and on signs, billboards and other advertisements. Believe it or not, QR codes have even been placed on tombstones to share information about the deceased! Smartphone users simply open their camera app, hover over the QR code, wait for the link to appear, and click on the link.

Here are some QR codes for you to try. (If you are viewing this newsletter on your cell phone, you will need to close the newsletter first. Then, open the newsletter on another device and use your cell phone’s camera to scan the QR codes below.)



If you successfully scanned the QR codes above, you probably noticed how easily you were redirected to each website. You did not need to type a long web address into your browser. You did not have to ask, “Is it http: or https:?” , “Is it / or \?” , “Is that a zero or an O?” or “Do I need to type www?”.

QR codes can be a valuable tool for your MJM TEAM. Free QR code generators may be found online. If you are not comfortable with creating your own QR code, I am happy to do this for you. Simply give me the web address that you want your QR code to be linked to and I will return the image to you by email or text. From there, you may print your QR code on anything you wish!
