## Motorcyclists for Jesus and the Back Patch

Greetings in the precious name of our Lord Jesus, I've been asked to share some thoughts on what to wear and what not. MJM has "NO" defined policy on what members should wear and what to avoid. I can only comment from the perspective of the area in which I reside and maybe some suggestions that you could put before the Lord in prayer.

Our handbook mentions that the large back patch should be worn for the following reasons;  
What "back patches" are to be worn by members of Motorcyclists for Jesus Ministries?

Members are encouraged to wear the large Motorcyclists for Jesus Ministries patch on the back of their vest or jacket for purposes of identification, continuity, and uniformity at events.

Other than the above statement MJM does not share any other thoughts about our vests or jackets that we wear.

Luke 9:23 Then he said to them all: "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me. When I meditate on this scripture I can envision a person carrying the cross, but what would that image look like. Can you see a set of crosshairs? This verse gives us a sense of how the world views us when we serve as Jesus' disciples. So with image in mind let's talk about the vests & Jackets we wear!

In our area rockers of any kind are frowned upon, rockers are what most M/C members earn as part of membership. Please note the following from [https://www.facebook.com/permalink.php?story\\_fbid=166448923456821&id=163423760426004](https://www.facebook.com/permalink.php?story_fbid=166448923456821&id=163423760426004)

Excerpt from the facebook page: "Rockers: The rockers are the curved patches at the bottom and top. Riding clubs cannot wear them unless approved by the dominant riding club in the area. Social MCs and riding clubs should not claim territory by using the rockers. Do not sew the state name onto your vest or jacket without club approval".

Denim vests from blue jean jackets can be worn in our area with the sleeves cut off and only the sleeves. MJM has membership in numerous states, we should always consider this! So wearing any type of support patches or memorial patches from clubs in ones' area would not be advisable. If an MJM member travels to another area with support patches on it would be presumed that all MJM members {everywhere} wear those patches as well. This would not be helpful to the members of this ministry. Wearing color schemes that represent club colors would not be advisable either; for example if a club in one area of the USA wears pink and gray as their "colors" and you wear a small patch on your vest in another area of the USA that has pink and gray in it, wearing that patch color scheme may have you explaining the reasons why you are wearing that patch.

Consider this John 15:17-19 The World Hates the Disciples 18 "If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. 19 If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you. Jesus gave us this verse to tell us how we would be viewed as "Christians" if this verse is true and I know it is, then why would we want to create more conflict with M/C's by wearing patches that would only serve to diminish our witness or be seen as a "sign of disrespect". When we have enough obstacles to get around / jump over by just by being "Christians"? Going out into the motorcycle community serving God should be first and foremost in mind and not concerning ourselves with looking like the world!!! Let our Love, Faith, and Hope be the visible tools we wear, not patches!!!

## A NOTE FROM OUR NATIONAL ROAD REP.

Well, March is here, at least that is what the calendar says? Can't prove it by us though; it is still wicked cold and snowing as I am writing this article for our March Voice Newsletter.

2015 is proving to be a growing year for MJM already, Praise The Lord!

We have two new T.E.A.M.s that joined MJM last month. The first new T.E.A.M. in PA Cruisers For The Cross started out with 13 members! Now there is a T.E.A.M. on the move for Christ. I have never chartered a T.E.A.M. this large in my 5 years as acting NRRRA and don't see any in recent history either. Our second new T.E.A.M. is in VA they are Cornerstone Riders.

I would like to welcome these two new T.E.A.M.s to our MJM Family. This brings a total of three new T.E.A.M.s in the first two months of 2015. I feel this just shows that God is showing MJM favor as we move forward in the right direction in serving our Lord.

I would also like to welcome Vern Hawkins back as our KY Road Rep. Thank you Vern for excepting the BOD's invitation to step back up to the plate as our KY Road Rep. I look forward to working with you once again.

Last but certainly not least, I need the Presidents of ALL T.E.A.M.s aside from those that have started since Jan. 2015 and the two that have already sent them in, to send me your 2015 Officer updates. Without these updates I have no idea if a T.E.A.M. is truly a current T.E.A.M. I used the information on the website and in the Voice Newsletter to contact the last known T.E.A.M. Presidents (contacts). If you are a President of a T.E.A.M. and did not receive an email with the update form attached this means your T.E.A.M. has not been updated as required in the last year. If you have not received the email with the form please contact me and I will get the form to you.

If your T.E.A.M. has not had any changes from the previous year I still need to know this via the Officers Update form. I cannot/will not just assume this to be the fact I need it in writing via the form.

I as did previous NRRRA's have been very lenient in not acting when these forms are not returned on a yearly basis. This has come to an end in 2015 I expect and updated Officer Form yearly from here on forward. These updates are required no later than Feb 28th each year. If I do not receive an updated Officer list by this time I will have to consider the T.E.A.M. Inactive. All Inactive T.E.A.M.s will be removed from the website and the Voice Newsletter until said T.E.A.M. has contacted me with Officer Updates. There will be one reminder request made before a T.E.A.M. is considered Inactive. This year and this year only the date of Inactive status for un-updated Officer information will be March 31th.

These updates are a requirement of our 2012 Handbook and have always been a needed requirement. If potential members go to the website and try to contact someone who is not the appropriate person it shines badly on MJM as a whole. I have one contact on the site whose email doesn't even exist. I have contacted this person via two other email addresses' I happened to have and still have had no response from this "President/Contact".

One the other hand we have a T.E.A.M. that sends me promptly every year a complete T.E.A.M. roster with all Officers clearly noted. This is an ideal update list for our T.E.A.M. files. I find this the preferred update as it shows us how many members a T.E.A.M. has each year. Thank you.

Please don't feel as I am coming down hard on our T.E.A.M. Presidents I am finally doing an important part of my job as NRRRA that has not been taken seriously for years. One reason for this is the time it takes to continuously request this information only to be ignored month after month and year after year. To the T.E.A.M.s that update their information yearly I thank you very much for your helping me do my job as I am assigned to do it.
