By, The Word among us Devotional:

Psalm 139:13

You formed my inmost being; you knit me in my mother's womb.

Imagine that it's your birthday, and God prepares a magnificent dinner party in your honor. All your family and friends are in attendance, and everyone is enjoying themselves immensely. Just before the food comes out, God steps up to the microphone and asks everyone to settle down. Then, clearing his throat, he looks right at you and says:

"Do you know the very thought of you fills me with joy? From the moment of your conception, I put a lot of thought into who you were going to be: the shape of your eyes, the tone of your voice, your personality, your talent, and your dreams. I could never keep my eyes off of you, even when you couldn't see me. I wept when you wept, and I took great pride in every one of your successes and triumphs. All these years, I have loved you and treasured you.

That's right. I've been with you all along. I know every intimate detail about you. Not a single moment of your life passed without my seeing it and feeling it within the depths of my heart. I may have created you, but I marvel at the way you are using all the gifts I have given you. I marvel even more at the future I have in store for you. I can't wait for the day when you are able to join me in my heavenly home.

Prayer: Connecting with the heart, meditating on our innermost being, and contemplating on the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

Prayer takes us in three directions: prayer takes us “inward” as we seek transformation in our lives; “upward” as we seek the intimacy with Jesus we desire; and “outward” as we minister to the needs of others. This month I want to complete the journey “upward” as we seek intimacy with Jesus through heart-felt, meditative and contemplative prayers.

When we pray from the heart, we have intimacy with God. Heart-felt prayer has been referred to also as “abba prayer”. Our hearts are symbolic of the center of our emotions and feelings. It is that center that God listens to and touches. Our Christian heritage is rooted in Jewish theology. Jewish children use the terms “abba” and “imma” to refer to father and mother.

We read in Galatians 4:6: “Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit calls out, “Abba, Father.” To quote Richard Foster, “ontologically, Jesus’ relationship with God the Father is, of course, absolutely unique, but experientially, we are invited into the same intimacy with Father God that he knew while here in the flesh. In other words, Jesus modeled how we are to pray to God. Our heart is where we find the Holy Spirit present in our lives. We are commanded to love God with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength. Ultimately, however we connect with the center of our being (our heart) and we connect with God, we experience a warming of our heart and are touched by the love of God.

As we center ourselves in what is in our hearts, we can then transition to meditation on the experience followed by contemplation, all expressions of prayer. A meditative spirit opens our soul (hearts) to receive what God has for us, rather than seeking to control God by our requests or expression of our needs and questions. All expressions have a place in prayer and therefore one recognizes that prayer is multi-dimensional (we are only looking at two expressions of prayer in this article). Meditation can start with *meditatio Scripturarum* (meditation upon Scripture) as a reference point and then progress into a personal experience as Scripture touches our lives through the guidance of the Holy Spirit and we personalize its teachings. That is when we say that “God spoke to us personally through the reading of the Bible or Scripture.” We move from detachment to attachment, an intellectual experience of the Bible, to an emotional experience of the Bible. We truly experience the Bible. *Lectio divina* (divine reading) is where the mind connects with the heart. In meditative prayer, God addresses the individual.

At this point we have first centered our hearts on God; we have reflected and mediated through meditative prayer on God’s Scripture, and now that He has addressed us, we can enter a state of contemplative prayer where we seek His presence and guidance in our lives as we continue on life’s journey. Contemplative prayer is where we experience silence in the presence of the Holy Spirit and is also a very deep or intense experience of God in our lives where we enter into interior communion. Contemplative prayer captures what is in the words “abide in me as I abide in you.” At this point we have experienced Divine Union. We become what God created us to be. We are lead into purity of heart. As Jesus said in Matthew 5:8: “Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.”

As we truly see what is in our hearts in our efforts to see ourselves as God sees us; as we read the Scripture and study the Bible, and as we contemplate on how the Holy Spirit has spoken to us – we are transformed. We are then are called to an outward expression of our faith (moving outward) as God uses us to reach out to and share His love with others.




