## T.E.A.M. OF THE MONTH

Our TEAM with MJM is called The Vermont Christian Riders. We started our spiritual motorcycle journey with MJM when a good friend of ours came to our house with information about MJM. We all decided to look it over and pray about it. Since we all received a positive feeling in our spirit, we decide to try MJM for a year. It wasn't long after we joined that Peter Wong called and wanted to meet with us to welcome us into MJM.

Since we have been in MJM we have seen members come and go, but we still persevere, mostly because we have met some wonderful brothers and sisters in the Lord as well as knowing this organization is God oriented. This was what He called us to do. We decide to go to a Bikers Sunday in Columbus Ohio. When we got there, there were over 3000 bikers and almost as soon as we got off our bike we walked right into Karl and Kerma Wardlaw.

We started our riding season off with a free booth at a swap meet in April. Next, we traveled to the spring swap meet in Keene, N.H. where there are usually over a thousand bikers. From there, Lord willing head to the spring kickoff.

We spend one day at Americade, and then I go to Laconia Bike week from Sunday until Saturday, my bike sits on the street from 7:00 a.m. until 11:00 p.m. with the MJM banner tied to the front of it. I have Bibles and tracts with me to hand out as well as witness to people when the opportunity arises. There is usually over 200,000 people at the rally. After Laconia we do a few events and TEAM rides where we invite anyone to come along if they would like.

Then, in July, we take part in the Christian 4th of July parade. We are on the steering committee, plus we have a booth at the event after the parade. After that we get ready for the ride for the Unborn with the Vermont Right to Life Committee. I am also on this steering committee and lead the ride out of Rutland, Vt. to the State House in Montpelier, VT.

At these events, or on these rides, we share the love of Jesus at every chance we have and we always start our rides off with a prayer.

In Aug. we gear up for the Gathering of the Tribes which is always a blessing. Our TEAM has been invited to the CMA end of the year celebration in Plattsburgh, N.Y., where we end the season by going to Keene, N.H. and ride with Cornerstone Ministry. A short ride to the Cathedral in the Pines for a short service outdoors and then a free apple pie and ice cream.

Our main scripture verse is Mark 16:15. Our calling from God is to go out and let everyone know about the Love of Jesus.

Prayer should be a conversation, a way of exercising and celebrating our relationship with God.

Constant asking does not make for a good relationship.

If we're serious about having a relationship with God, a good rule of thumb is to begin our prayers with praise and thanksgiving. That way, if we run out of time, we will have gotten to the important, relationship-building part.

God will take care of our needs and honor our requests. He proves that every day. So, will we honor him with our thanks?

### Pecan Sweet Potato Casserole

4 cups sweet potatoes cubed  
1/2 cup sugar  
2 eggs  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
4 tablespoons butter, soften  
1/2 cup milk

1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract  
1/2 cup packed brown sugar  
1/2 cup all purpose flour  
3 tablespoons butter, soften  
1/2 cup chopped pecans

#### Directions

325 degrees for 30 minutes

- 1- Cook sweet potatoes until tender, drain and mash
- 2- Mix together, sweet potatoes, white sugar, eggs, salt, butter, milk and vanilla until smooth. Put in 9x13 inch baking dish.
- 3- Mix brown sugar, flour then cut in the butter until mixture is coarse. Stir in pecans. Sprinkle over sweet potato mixture and bake.
