### Thanks to Brother Ken for your recipe this month!

Rhubarb-Buttermilk Muffins

400 degrees 15-20 minutes

1 1/2 c brown sugar	1/2 c salad oil
1 egg	2 tsp vanilla extract
1 c butter milk	1 1/2 finely diced rhubarb
1/2 c pecan pieces	2 1/2 c all purpose flour
1 tsp baking powder and baking soda	1/2 tsp salt

Topping:

1/2 c sugar, 1 1/2 tsp cinnamon, an 1 tbsps melted margarine mixed together.

Grease 24 medium sized muffin cups.

Combine in a large bowl, brown sugar, oil, eggs, vanilla. Beat well.

Stir in buttermilk, rhubarb, and pecans.

In another bowl, sift together flour, baking soda, baking powder, and salt.

Add to rhubarb mixture, stir until moist. Do Not over mix.

Fill muffin pan 3/4 full, top with the topping mixture.

Bake 400 degrees for 15-20 minutes

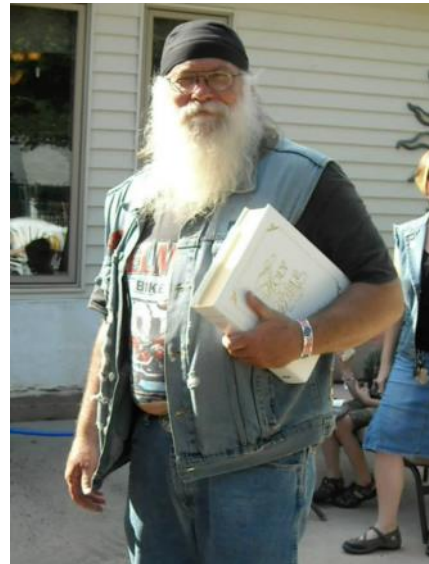
