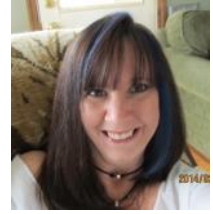

How to Listen to the Voice of God

I have found there are two kinds of listeners.... The first kind are passive and nonchalant - people who can “take it or leave it” when it comes to the Bible.

Then there are those who are aggressive listeners. These people have a look of hunger on their faces. They attend church to learn more about God and to worship Him. They are not there to hear a pastor speak. Instead, they are present to hear from God. There is a huge difference.

An aggressive listener wants to hear truth even when it may be painful to assimilate. He hungers for righteousness and thirsts to know more about the ways of God, and he yearns to find out the answers to his questions by probing and studying the Bible. People who are aggressive listeners will take notes, reread them during the week, and ask God to show them how what they have heard applies to their lives. They are not afraid to become involved with the active study of His Word. They want to know the truth because they have learned a great secret - the more they know about God, the more peace, contentment, hope, joy, and blessing they experience. If you read and study His Word, He will bless you.

Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of the prophecy, and heed the things which are written in it; for the time is near. - Revelation 1:3

God wants you to be an aggressive listener of His Word because He wants you to be able to comprehend the truth. He knows if you do this, your life will be radically changed for Him.

What are His goals for you in reading and listening to His Word? He wants you to understand His truth so you can apply it to your life. He wants you to be transformed by what you read, study, and hear.

So is My word that goes out from My mouth: it will not return to Me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it. - Isaiah 55:11

God not only has a purpose for your life, He has a purpose for the words He speaks to you. There have been times in my life when the only two words I heard from the Lord were, “Trust Me.” And I was committed to do just that - trust Him even though I did not know where He was leading me or what I would do. He knew, He is sovereign, and He has promised to love me forever. How could I doubt His ability and goodness?

And yet, when trials come or situations take a course other than the one we have planned, we suddenly find ourselves crying out like Peter, “Lord, save me!” It is times like this that we should turn to His Word, because it will transform us and remove our doubts and fears. It teaches us how to trust Him even when the way before us appears to be a dead end.

He opened the Red Sea for the nation of Israel, and He will do the same for you when you need to pass through to a place of safety.

Week after week, as you are in His Word, He is putting Scripture into your heart and He is molding and shaping your life for something absolutely wonderful. You can trust this: the time you spend learning His truths will not be wasted. He is planning to use you in ways you never dreamed possible, but first you must be trained by His Word. When you and I begin to comprehend the truth and allow God to conform us to that truth, then our lives will take on an undeniable likeness to Jesus Christ, and we gain all the benefit of knowing God and seeing Him work in and through us.

When problems come, we know how to stop and think through them by asking the Lord to show us how to respond. We are not reacting any more; we are responding according to what we have learned from God.

Remember the story of Mary and Martha in Luke 10:38-42? Is there any doubt as to why Mary was sitting at the feet of Jesus? She truly had learned what was most important - the Word of God - and she chose to spend time listening to Him instead of busying herself with the things of the world.

What is most important to you? To be seen, noticed, or stroked for your professional ability, or to know that you are loved and cared for by an awesome loving God who has you in the center of His will and affections?

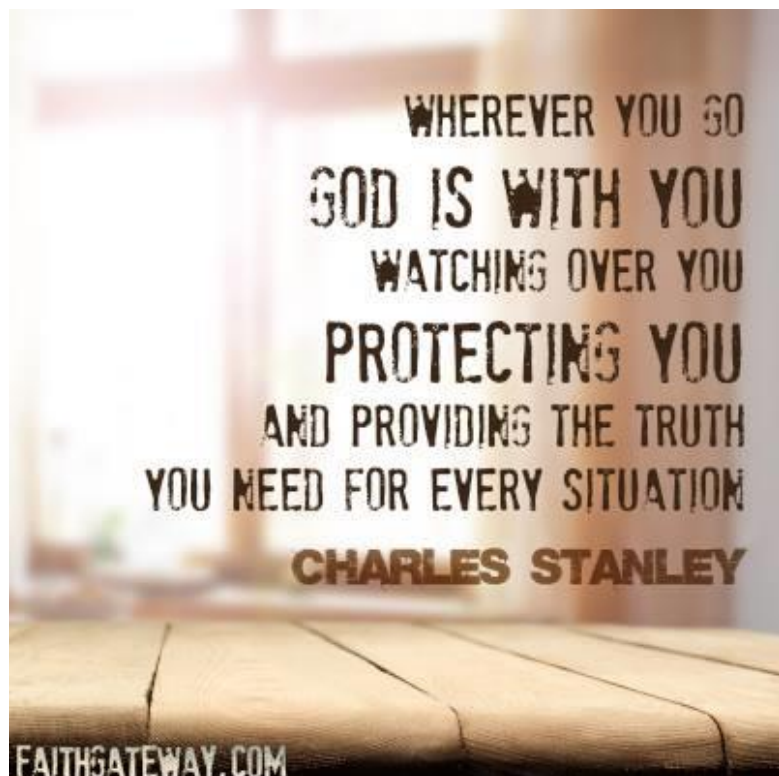
This is one of the occasions when God allows you to decide: you can resist Him and His Word, or you can receive Him and the truth He wants to pour into your life. If you accept His invitation to come, He will give you His peace to stand guard over your life.

He wants to communicate with you. I find this one fact very humbling. To think the God of the universe wants to know me, speak to me, and help me understand how to live is more than I can comprehend. He knew Joshua was struggling, and instead of just sending some simple word of encouragement, He came Himself and reminded young Joshua that there was no need to be afraid because he was not alone. The absolute Ruler of everything was with him, and he was not going to fail. When our hearts are weary and we want to give up, His Word of encouragement gives us the strength to go beyond what we believe we can do. Joshua had no idea how he would lead Israel, but God knew and He had promised to guide him.

Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go. - Joshua 1:9 Wherever you go, God is with you - watching over you, protecting you, and providing the truth you need for every situation. The question is, will you open your heart to His Word, apply it to your life, and allow God to change you so that He can use you in ways far greater than you can imagine?

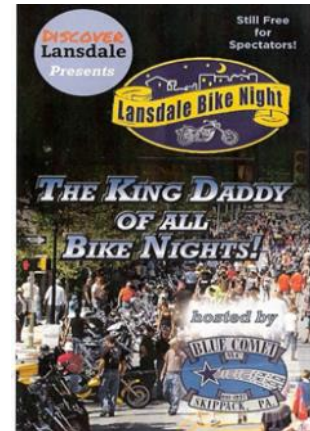

LACONIA BIKE WEEK 2014

I know as I get ready for Laconia Bike week that going over to it has been a calling from the Lord for me to do since 1999. It's 100 miles from my house to where I camp out at Dave Plants which is a blessing to have a place to stay as he has setup for Christian Bikers to come to, and have a place of rest when they aren't out on the street ministering to the bikers that need Jesus and that need to hear the gospel.

I try and take over a hundred Bibles or more to put out on my bike for the people to take with them plus booklets of the Gospel of John as well as an assortment of tracts, as they are looking at the items I have out on display with the Lords leading I ask them what they think about Jesus. By doing this some will respond and talk about Jesus and going to church, for example one guy shared with me how he was having problems in his family plus the struggles in his life which gave me an opportunity to share the love of Jesus with him.

Then there are some people that have tried to give me money as a donation for what I am doing by giving out this things and I say I am sorry but I can't take it for as the Bible says freely receive freely give, I have freely received the salvation of Jesus into my life and now I am freely giving the same to you but it is your choice.

I also have met other Christian bikers that I have made friends with, one is Bible Biker he has a black Goldwing with murals from the left side of the front tire all the way around to the right of the front tire it starts out with the first of God's creation on Adam and Eve to the end times, plus I have a few churches that I visit right close by that have free water and coffee plus some literature of the gospel, I have been on a ride thru with the parade for the POW and MIA's there are so many on that ride thru it takes about 20 minutes for all of us to go thru.

I helped out at the Cornerstone ministries tent just out of Keene NH. one year, at times there are so many bikers coming thru that for morning breakfast I used 10 loaves of bread for toast and 12 pots of coffee from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 there was 8 or 10 of us working and it kept us all busy until the last biker rolled out. they had Bibles and tracts on the tables for the bikers to read.

There are at least 200 to 300 vendors if not more, with the Lords leading while I am going thru looking at their merchandise I talk to them as well. There is a lot of ministry to share at these big rallies, I even shared the gospel with a couple of people parking cars and motorcycles. Or you are headed for Weirs beach and you are in a line of bikes that are a half a mile from Weirs and you are doubled up and it takes you about a half an hour to get there so you have a chance to strike up a conversation with the biker next to you.

As Isaiah 6:8-10, the voice of speaks are we ready to respond in a positive way and are we ready to make straight the path for the lost to follow?

Pappy's Award for MJM TEAM's

Jim "Pappy" Strous' born 2/17/1956, home with Jesus 5/28/2009, Pappy had a heart to minister; his objective was to captivate the attention of everyone, Christian or not, with his love for Christ. He did this by volunteering Gettysburg Bike week. Set up booths at Swap meets, served Breakfast at BFHD for the employees free of charge. Planned a Bike Blessing at Battlefield H-D in which 1000's of Bikers still hear of God's love for them. Volunteered to help other organizations with their rides, served as a Member of HOG chapter and then offered the position of Chaplain for the chapter. Worked at getting his Pastoral Credits to perform weddings, renewal of vows, baptisms, served numerous hours with Shining Stars – helping those with special needs, Ministered for the Cowboy Church, would visit accident victims and people in nursing homes, shared Jesus with staff at the Cancer Institute. He invited the media to everything in order to make Jesus visible to the community.

He loved the ones whom others were afraid to, no matter the way they looked (bikers), the way they were born (disabilities), or the illnesses they may have (cancer).

Pappy lived out the following verse; 1st Samuel 16:7 "People look at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart"

His actions were louder than his words. With this in mind the board voted to approve the Jim "Pappy" Strous MJM TEAM award presented each year to an MJM TEAM that displays and lives out 1st Samuel 16:7.

MJM Pappy's Award

Pappy's Award is designed to be "Awarded" to MJM TEAM's only. This award will be given the MJM TEAM that best represents the vision for outreach and evangelism in the Motorcycle Community. The TEAM must be nominated by a member from another TEAM or one of MJM's many TEAMS. The TEAM that would be nominated would be focused on meeting the needs of various Charities in their regional areas, promotes and attends Motorcycle Events, and supports MJM National and local TEAM. The TEAM that would be awarded this recognition would have their TEAM name on a plaque and hold the award for one year. The award would be presented annually to different TEAM's in MJM. Once a TEAM is nominated and selected the MJM Board of Directors would contact the TEAM President to see which members on that TEAM would receive the Memorial Patch to wear. Only TEAM Members that support the local TEAM and National ministry would get awarded the patch and would receive their TEAM name on a small name plate to be listed as recipients of the award. Each year another TEAM would be added to the plaque.
